

FAQs for LCCA Dual Enrollment Students

Fall 2020

FAQs:

- What will my Lanier Tech classes at LCCA look like?
 - o Class sizes have been limited to ensure social distancing is maintained
 - o Masks and/or face shields will be required for all students in class
- When will my Lanier Tech classes begin?
 Courses will begin digitally on Monday, August 17. Students must log-in to their Blackboard account on this day to verify attendance. In-person classes will begin at LCCA on Monday, August 24.
- When in-person instruction begins on August 24, do I still have to attend my dual enrollment classes on the days I am scheduled for virtual instruction at the high school?
 LCCA Dual Enrollment students are expected to attend their dual enrollment courses each day. Those who elected for in-person instruction will be permitted to attend their home high school every day in order to ride the bus to LCCA for dual enrollment.
- Will students be able to stay at their home high school during the time they are scheduled for classes at LCCA?

No. Students will need to be on the LCCA campus during their schedule class times.

- Will masks/face shields be worn at LCCA?
 - Yes. Lanier Tech requires all students to wear a mask and/or face shield while in their courses. Faculty and staff will also be required to wear masks and/or face shields at all times. Lanier Tech courses will follow social distancing guidelines.
- Are students who choose the virtual high school option still allowed to come to LCCA for their dual enrollment courses?
 - Yes, as long as the student drives to and from LCCA. Virtual students may NOT drive to the home high school campus either before or after LCCA classes, nor may they use the district buses. The only exception will be for approved clubs and sports at the end of the school day.
- Will students have access to water foundations?
 - No. However, the touchless water fill fountains are available, so students are encouraged to bring in a water bottle.
- Will temperatures be taken?
 - All students riding the bus to/from LCCA will have their temperature taken. Additionally, upon entering the building, all students will have their temperature checked.
- What about buses?

Buses to and from LCCA will social distance as much as possible. Students and drivers will be required to wear face covering and sanitize their hands before boarding. When possible, windows will be open to increase ventilation. Busses will be cleaned and disinfected thoroughly between routes.

• Can dual enrollment students use the August 21 date to opt out of DE classes?

Students must adhere to the add/drop dates established by Lanier Tech. Please see dates below.

August 12:

Textbook pick-up at The Oaks from 8am – 5pm

August 13:

Textbook pick-up at The Oaks from 8am – 5pm

August 17:

First day of classes for Lanier Technical College – all students must log-in to their blackboard account on this day. The first week of class will be digital.

August 21:

LAST day to add/drop Lanier Tech courses. Withdrawing from classes after this date may affect dual enrollment funding eligibility and will count towards the 30-hour dual enrollment funding allowance.

August 24:

First day of in-person classes for Lanier Technical College – all students will report to LCCA during their schedule class time(s).
