## Interested in Dual Enrollment

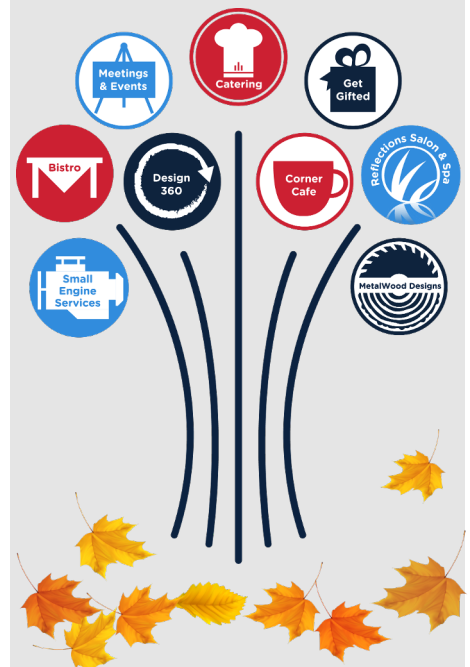

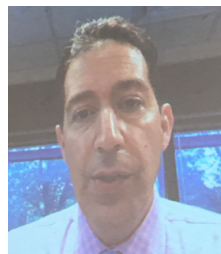


## WSB-TV's Mark Arum joins LCCA students

Several classes at LCCA had the unique opportunity to Zoom chat with local celebrity, WSB reporter and podcast host, Mark Arum on Thursday, September 3. Arum is known for his inventive traffic reports where he & fellow anchor, Fred Blankenship, often jazz up the news using hip hop lyrics.

In late August, Arum discussed on his show the plight of educators and parents who were teaching virtually. He insisted that "it takes a village," and he graciously offered to be part of the village that supports Georgia students.

We emailed Arum's producer and inquired about a Zoom call with the students of LCCA. Arum quickly responded, and set up a 15 minute call. While speaking to our students, Arum discussed what he believed were the most important employability traits.



He said that his success could be boiled down to three principles: 1. Never be late to work. 2. Never call out "fake sick" to work. 3. Be willing to do whatever is asked of you. Arum also joked that "everyone loves the guy who brings donuts to work." Arum spoke briefly about how writing concisely & efficiently helped him to be successful in his industry, and he encouraged our students to always smile and keep a positive attitude.
